Scheme of Examination. The selection will be made strictly on the basis of merit. The selection process will comprise of written test and skill test. Final merit will be decided on the basis of marks obtained in written test and skill tests wherever applicable. The question paper of written test will be bilingual i.e., English & Hindi. However, the questions on the portion of English language subject will be in English only.

Syllabus for Examination:-

- General English. The questions will be of 10th standard. Candidate's understanding the basics of English language. Its vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, synonyms, antonyms and its correct usage, etc. His/her writing ability would
- 2. Numerical Aptitude. This paper will include questions on problems relating to number systems, computation of whole numbers, decimals & fractions and relationship between numbers, fundamental arithmetic operations, percentage, ratio & proportion, averages, interest, profit & loss, discount, use of table and graphs, mensuration, time & distance, ratio & time, time & work etc.
- 3. General Intelligence & Reasoning. The question will be of 10th standard and would include questions of non-verbal type. The test may include questions on analogies, similarities & differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, Judgment, decision making visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship concepts, figure classification, arithmetical number series, non-verbal series. The test will also include questions designed to test the candidate's abilities to deal with

abstract ideas and symbols and their relationship, arithmetic computation and to her

4. Current & General Awareness. The questions will be of 10th standard. The questions will be designed to test the ability of candidate's general awareness of the environment around him/her and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of 10th standard educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries especially pertaining to sports, history, culture, geography, economic science, general policy including Indian constitution and scientific research etc. These questions will be such that, they do not require a special study of any discipline.

- (c) Photocopy of caste certificate/non-creamy layer certificate, disability certificate 'A' in case of OBC candidate, duly attested.
- (d) Attested copy of any one valid national unique ID proof like Adhaar Card/ Pan Card/ Voter ID

Important Instructions to the Candidates/ Applicants:-

- (a) Date of examination 21 Mar 2021 at 0800 hrs (reporting) & 1000 hrs (exam). No separate call up letter will be sent to the eligible candidates to check their names on School website before appearing in the written exam (www.rashtriya militaryschools.edu.in).
- (b) Location of examination centre Rashtriya Military School, Chail, District Solan (HP).
- (c) Persons working in Central/State Govt/PSU must apply through proper channel along with the certificate from the establishment that no disciplinary action is contemplated/pending against them and that they have no objection in releasing them in case of selection
- (d) New entrants to Government service, entering on or after 01 Jan 2004 are governed by the New Defined Contribution Pension System (known as New Pension Scheme).
- (e) The Commandant/Principal shall not be responsible for any postal delay or failure.
- (f) The Commandant/Principal reserves the right not to fill up any or all the post(s) advertised and may change the number of vacancies if necessary. The vacancies mentioned herewith are subject to increase/decrease/cancelled without notice.
